

Notes for Highway, Footpaths & Lighting Committee

Scheduled Meeting for Tuesday 4th June deferred until 16th July 2013

1 Double Yellow Lining TRO 2013

- (a) TRO Section 53 Northend – Traffic Order proposed 17th May and legitimacy queried with Kris Gardom (B&NES). The HFL requested a site visit but still to be arranged – and urging.
- (b) TRO Section 23 Estate. Positive response from B&NES that officer Peter Bailey will site visit with HFL representatives.
Still waiting a proposed date and urging.

2 Bannerdown Road

- (c) Cllr Caroline Roberts (the new B&NES Cabinet Member for Transport) has been invited by VP to meet with the Jane Scott (Wiltshire CEO) and Shirley Parker (Colerne District Councillor) to discuss HGV traffic problem on bannerdown road.
Meeting date not yet established.
- (d) Missing tarmac just above Barnfield Way has been reported and action by B&NES Highways anticipated.

3 Pavement at Shops

- (e) Monies confirmed by B&NES Cabinet in April 2013.
- (f) Cllr David Dixon (B&NES Cabinet Member) has promised to ensure that the BPC is involved in the early design work.

4 River Crossing

- (g) B&NES has confirmed that the additional monies to complete this Bridge are now assured, and that the Bridge should be available next Spring.
- (h) Cllr David Dixon (B&NES Cabinet Member) has promised to ensure that the BPC is involved in the early design work.

5 Footpaths

- (j) The proposals for re-instatement of the Footpath across Solsbury Hill was queried by the landowner so the proposal has to be processed by the Planning Inspector.
Start date for this Inquiry is 7th May and Decision should be made by 13th August 2013.

6 Litter Bins

- (k) B&NES still has 'no monies' to replace/enhance existing bins.
Even if the BPC purchased Bins B&NES would NOT add them to the "Emptying Routine"
- (l) B&NES has been asked to provide annual costs for Maintenance and "Emptying" so that a possible Agency Agreement can be established and the BPC takes over this role.
